- Voted captain by teammates in 2009 and 2010

- Finished third in all-around at VISA Championships, including a program-record 90.0 in the finals
- Holds program record on rings with a 16.3 mark set vs. Oklahoma March 13, 2010
- Two-time U.S. national team member
