1. 2010 NCAA All-Around Champion

Chris Cameron won the All-Around with a 90.500, beating out his nearest competitor by a large 1.55 point margin. He qualified into event finals on floor exercise, pommel horse, still rings, and parallel bars.

Cameron showed team dedication at the 2009 Championships, foregoing all-around competition (because of the rules at the time limiting all-around exhibitions) in order to better his team's chances at a National Title.

Cameron would have only needed above a 14.90 on vault to potentially have also won the all-around at the 2009 NCAA Championships.

2. 2010 USA World Team Member

Chris Cameron was named to the USA World Team and competed at the 2010 Worlds in Rotterdam,

3. 2010 Big Ten All-Around Champion

Chris won the 2010 big Ten All-Around title and was named 2010 Big Ten Gymnast of the Year. He qualified into four event finals winning the floor exercise and placing second on still rings.

- 4.** Five-time All-American
Chris is a five-time All-American. All-Around, rings, and parallel bars at the 2010 NCAA Championships.
Floor and pommel horse at the 2009 NCAA Championships.
- 5.** Member of the USA Senior National Team since 2009
Chris was selected to the Senior National Team in February 2009 at the Winter Cup Challenge and has been a member since.
He has represented his country at the 2010 Pacific Rim Championships where he won pommel horse and took second on floor exercise;
the 2010 Japan Cup where he took ninth in the all-around; and most recently the 2010 World Championships.
