2010 Sun Devil Preview

In June of 1993, ASU gave the ax to its traditionally highly successful men's gymnastics program. In 1994, the ASU Sun Devil Gymnastics Team competed it's first year as a non-funded team and ended the year by winning the USA Collegiate National Championships with 10 All-Americans and one individual National Champion. Now beginning their 17th year as a "club" team, the team continues to grow in stature among its peers around the country. The squad size continues to grow as more gymnasts from around the country find a home to pursue their academic and gymnastic careers together.

With 8 new faces, this team is young with a lot of potential and room to grow. The team numbers 21 members strong, which encourages lots of internal competition just to make the team on each event.

Last year, the Devils retained the National Team Title in the collegiate division of the USAG Collegiate National Championships held in Springfield, MA and are looking to try to hold on to that title again this year.

Leading the charge this year will be our team veterans: All American **Charles Baysinger** from Nashville, TN and **Dillon Saunders** (Co-Captain) from Carmel Valley, CA will bring the experience needed to anchor the team with so many new freshman vying for a spot in the line-up. Last year's Freshman All Americans - **Alex Gaudaur** (Clovis, CA) and **Riley Barclay** (Co-Captain) from Chandler, AZ will both be returning to hold up their high standards and lead the charge toward the high goals set for this year's team. Rounding out the depth will be returning veterans **Cody Payne** (Norman, OK), **Josh Bradley** (Omaha, NE) and **Brock Leinberger** (Tempe, AZ) who will be leaned on quite heavily to round out the top 4 scores on each event.

Making up the strongest incoming freshman class to date are 3 gymnasts from Oasis Gymnastics in Glendale, AZ- Stewart MacDonald, Alex Cozza and Mychael Ramirez. Other freshmen from around the country that will looking to make a difference in this year's team are **Sam Cook** (Minnetonka, MN), **Hans Degnan** (Exeter, NH), **Brian Malone** (Brockton, MA), **Riley Morlen** (Navarre, FL) and **Lee Wilkerson** (Locust Grove, GA).

The team is currently enjoying their own home state-of-the-art training facility which they moved into in 2005 after loosing their workout facility on the campus of ASU in 2001. The new \$3.2 million training facility is a 32,000 sf sports center in Chandler, AZ providing opportunities for kids to get involved in gymnastics, Swimming, Tramp & Tumbling, Martial Arts and Dance. It is clearly one of the finest collegiate training facilities in the country.

Rounding out this team's training experience the Sun Devils will have the best of coaches on hand. **Dan Hayden** who was a NCAA National Champion gymnast on the ASU 1986 NCAA National Championship team will act this year as associate-head coach. Dan was one of our countries most decorated male Junior gymnasts, Olympic alternate and honored as both an ASU and USA Gymnastics Hall of Famer. **Rob Survick** (Idaho) was an ASU team member on 4 national championship teams and has been instrumental in leading the ASU program for the past 4 years as an assistant coach. Both Rob and Dan coach the Jr Sun Devil Program at the gym.

Now in their 17th year as a non-funded program, the team continues to attract talent from across the country. As a team, the Sun Devils travel and compete against most all of the NCAA teams as it did before losing its NCAA status. Although not being allowed to compete in the NCAA championships, the team does compete in the Collegiate National Championships hosted by USA Gymnastics.

Even though there are no scholarships and no financial backing from the university, this is a team of individuals who have a great love of the sport of gymnastics. Coached by former NCAA All-American and USA National Team member Scott Barclay, these student athletes have been willing to sacrifice a tremendous amount in order to participate and be a part of a great gymnastics tradition. Barclay feels strongly that "being a part of a college program like this gives them a chance to further their careers, build their character, be a part of a strong team program and go after their dreams. This team is all about Opportunity!" In the spirit of continuing the great Sun Devil Tradition of Men's Gymnastics, this team will once again carry the Pride of the Sun Devils into 2010 as they try to defend their National Team Title once again.
