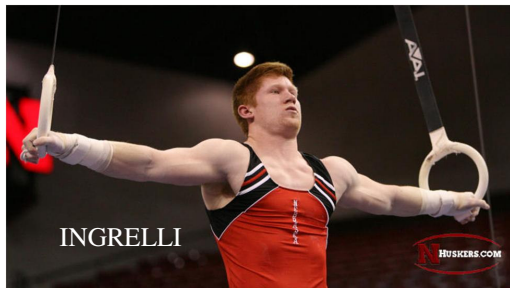


UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA: 12-12-10
